






Restricted and unrestricted funds were released by school administration under the guidance and approval of the Board of Directors.





Frassati Catholic Academy uses the NWEA MAP Assessment for students in grades 2-8 because it's an intuitive assessment that adjusts to each student as they take the test. Student progress is measured twice a year and their scores are made up of subtests which are identified in their reports. MAP scores help teachers as they plan instruction for individual students. We recognize and celebrate the individual growth that happens in each child and we are proud of the overall academic growth pattern we see from 2nd through 8th grade.

An RIT score is an estimation of a student's instructional level and also measures student progress or growth in school.
